




HOOKWORM LIFE CYCLE

(*Ancylostoma caninum*)

ANCYLOSTOMA CANINUM



Worms use their sharp teeth to bite and chew the pet's stomach and intestines. The biting causes blood loss, weakness and sores in stomach and intestine. Severe blood loss may be fatal, especially in young animals.



Humans become infected by eating fecally contaminated soil or food and by skin penetration of the larvae.

Larvae penetrate skin.

Larvae can be transferred to puppies and kittens before birth or through nursing.

Eggs hatch in feces to form larvae.
